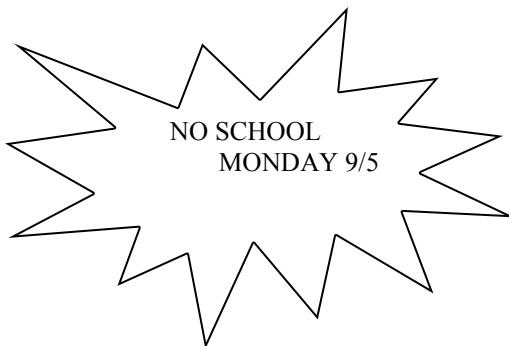


PTF Meeting
